

SUPPORTING MEDICAL DOCUMENTATION:

EPIC AUSTRALIA ADAPTIVE PASS

Anyone determined to have a permanent disability that severely limits one or more major life activities is eligible for the Epic Australia Adaptive Pass. Vail Resorts qualifies a permanent disability as a **permanent physical, cognitive, or sensory impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities, such as caring for oneself, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning, or working.**

This form is to be completed by a Health Professional, with the information used to assist the Epic Australia Pass team in determining a Pass holder's eligibility for the Epic Australia Adaptive Pass. *Note: Health Professional must be relevant to the nature of the Pass holder's disability.*
