SUPPORTING MEDICAL DOCUMENTATION:

EPIC AUSTRALIA ADAPTIVE PASS

Anyone determined to have a permanent disability that severely limits one or more major life activities is eligible for the Epic Australia Adaptive Pass. Vail Resorts qualifies a permanent disability as a **permanent physical**, **cognitive**, **or sensory impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities, such as caring for oneself, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning, or working.**

This form is to be completed by a Health Professional, with the information used to assist the Epic Australia Pass team in determining a Pass holder's eligibility for the Epic Australia Adaptive Pass. *Note: Health Professional must be relevant to the nature of the Pass holder's disability*.
